#### Cookie policy

#### 1.1.- What are cookies?

Cookies are text files hosted in the visitor's computer that store and retrieve browsing information. Although cookies always work in the same way, their purpose can vary as there are different types of cookies. Section 1.4 of this policy indicates the specific use of the cookies in this website.

## 1.2.- How to accept, deny or revoke consent regarding cookie installation.

This website has enabled a consent manager so when you enter our website, you can freely accept, deny or configure cookie installation. The following situations can therefore occur:

- Consent to install cookies (all or a selection): If you press the "Accept and continue" button, you consent to installing cookies so that all the cookies selected will be installed on your computer.
- **Configuration**: If you press the "Configure" button, a drop-down menu will appear where you can explicitly indicate the type of cookies you agree to install and which you do not. Only selected cookies will be installed.
- **Reject**: The configuration panel enables the option to reject all cookies by pressing the "Reject" button enabled for this purpose.

You can also delete the cookies by using the configuration options on each <u>browser</u>, to set different privacy levels so that, as an example, you can reject all cookies that a website like this might send you or even delete all cookies that might have been saved. To modify these parameters, you can ask the manufacturer for help or read the documentation on them provided below:

- Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Safari, Microsoft Edge, Internet Explorer and Opera.

# 1.3.- Private or incognito browsing.

Finally, aside from the chance to restrict or eliminate cookies, most web browsers allow you to visit sites using the method known as "private browsing", "incognito", or "inPrivate". This

functional feature implies that when the browser/tab is closed, any browsing data that might have been stored or generated (including cookies) will be deleted.

# 1.4.- Types of cookies used in this website.

<u>Technical</u>: These help to make a website user friendly by activating basic functions such as onpage browsing and access to secure areas of the page. The website does not work properly without these cookies. They are essential for the website to work correctly.

<u>Preference</u>: This allows the website to remember all the information that changes how the page behaves or how it looks, such as the preferred language or the region.

<u>Analytical</u>: They help to understand how visitors interact with the website by gathering and proving information on the number of users, their browsing behaviour on the website or their use of the contents and/or services offered. This information is used to improve the usability of the website, its contents, and the products and services offered on it.
